

Xathryn Greeley

Shares her Collected Tabletops at the 31st Annual Antiques, Vintage & Garden Show

ith more than 30 years experience in the interior design industry and a strong passion for all things antique and collectable, Kathryn Greeley makes for a perfect guest speaker at this year's 31st Annual Antiques, Vintage & Garden Show at the Orlando Museum of Art, presented by the Council of 101. She'll discuss her book, *The Collected Tabletop*, while showcasing examples and explaining her personal design philosophy, hopefully inspiring others to develop their own.

Kathryn's career began shortly after she obtained her bachelor's degree in interior design from Western Carolina University (part of the University of North Carolina). She started her own design business, Kathryn Greeley Designs. She went back to school to complete her master's because she thought she wanted to teach. "I found that my passion was really in the doing it, not the teaching it," she says.

Although Kathryn taught part time as an adjunct faculty member, she stuck to what she loved best. "Interior design is my No. 1 passion and my day job," she says. She's built up a client base throughout the Southeast, including clients in Tampa, Naples, Raleigh and Knoxville. She describes her interior design style as refined rustic. "I do a lot of work in the European, country-English house look which has sort of led to my design philosophy which is a 'collected, not decorated' look," she continues.

Kathryn feels her style complements the region in which she does most of her work. Her offices are actually located in Waynesville, N.C. — just west of Asheville, near Cashiers and Highlands. She was contacted by a Council of 101 member who found out about her during the annual Cashiers Designer Showhouse in which Kathryn participated.



That connection led her to becoming this year's guest speaker at the Antiques Vintage & Garden Show, where Kathryn will speak and sign copies of her book, *The Collected Tabletop*. The book offers entertaining ideas and advice, while also showcasing tabletops featuring Kathryn's and some of her clients' antique collections.

"My passion for using antiques and vintage collections for tabletops came 35 years ago when I started collecting Flow Blue porcelain," she admits. "I often joke and tell people my retirement account is invested in Flow Blue. It's very addictive as are many of my other collections." Her collection obsession combined with
